Measurement

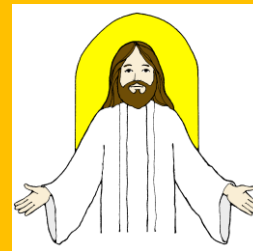
Length & Mass
